After a review of the documents you provided to the NCAA Eligibility Center, it has been determined that the Allendale Academy is a program that supports home-schooled students and families; therefore, it is not necessary for the Allendale Academy to establish or maintain a list of NCAA courses.

The NCAA Eligibility Center has a process to perform initial-eligibility certifications for students enrolled in programs determined to be home school by design. College-bound student-athletes who use the Allendale Academy as an umbrella administrator for their courses, transcripts and diplomas will be evaluated as home-schooled students consistent with practices for all students who are identified as home schooled.
