Allendale Academy's High School Graduation Requirements are set by the State of Florida. Florida's state graduation requirements are based on the year a student enters 9th grade. The specific requirements for each entering 9th grade class are listed at this Link [Official Florida Department of Education Graduation Charts](#)

As the parents of a high school student, you will need to fill out the enclosed High School Planning Sheets and keep it with your portfolio. This is to help you in planning for your student's four years of high school, so they will have the credits required for a diploma and/or college admission. If you have any questions, or need help in filling out the planning sheets, let us know. If you're not sure yet which subjects will be taken each year, fill out those you know (following the guideline for credits in the High School portion of the Handbook and the Florida Department of Education table at the link above). You can always add or make changes later.

Also, for your student's high school career, please keep the portfolio (as detailed in the Allendale Academy Handbook) for the entire four years of high school. This differs from the requirement to keep a portfolio for two years, as specified for grades K-8.
